ministry with **NEIGHBORHOOD** MINISTRY's outreach to the M\*\*m community in Assam continues to bear fruit with ever increasing numbers of new believers being prepared for baptism. November 30-December 2 Rev. Karl Dumas, an ABC Pastor from Utah, joined us in conducting a House Church Leader Training program with 80 leaders of house church-

es. The participants expressed their appreciation for the teaching on discipleship and leadership, especially pertinent as the majority have been believers less than two years. These training programs will continue on a regularly thrice annually thanks to a generous

grant from the Great Rivers Region!

NBCA is the most recently formed association within the Nagaland Baptist Church Council. These 64 churches serve the non-Naga's in Nagaland, as well as the growing community of inter-tribal families who are unable to worship in their tribal church of origin due to language barriers. This is a young but growing body of believers!

## INDO-BHUTAN LEADERS

We continue to provide leadership and discipleship training along the Bhutan border where 49 churches have been planted among the tea garden population. These churches focus outreach within the closed Buddhist nation of Bhutan.

In our last program we'd intended to provide discipleship training to new believers who travel down the mountains from Bhutan. Due to the sudden imprisonment of a Christian the intended participants were unable to leave their village. We suddenly switched gears and

gathered leaders from the new local churches and presented leadership training. PLEASE PRAY as we return in March to conduct that discipleship training program for Bhutanese believers.

The venue, a tent in the midst of rice fields, was the size of 4 football fields, where 200,000 worshipers sat on straw on the cold ground during all the services. For the Sunday morning service the sides of the tent were raised to accommodate an additional 100,000 people gathered outside! It was a powerful time of worship as voices resounded in the song "I Have Decided to Follow Jesus", a chorus composed by one of their own Garo tribe and now cherished worldwide. This was also attended by Dr. Benjamin Chan, our Area Director and his special assistants for India.

**INDIA BAPTIST SUMMIT OCTOBER 3-6, 2019** We are excited and blessed by the fruit borne from the 2014 India Mission Summit in Kohima where all our Indian partners gathered to seek God and explore ways to work together to reach India. We are encouraged by the successful ministries of the two Commissions on Anti-Human Trafficking and Religious Liberty (Justice for All), as well as the Forums for



Women and Youth which were created from that event. We are now actively involved in the planning of the follow-up event, THE INDIA BAPTIST SUMMIT, in the South Indian city of Hyderabad. We, along with our Indian colleagues, Area Director, Ben Chan and his assistants, recently spent time

in that city meeting with key civic leaders and local Pastors in preparation for the anticipated 1200 participants in
