The **Rev. Hopeton Scott** has been Senior Pastor of the First Baptist Church of Bridgeport, Connecticut, since 1995, where Michael and Vivienne Friday have been members since 2014. He is a graduate of Central Connecticut State University, the United Theological



College of the West Indies, the University of the West Indies, and the University of St. Joseph in West Hartford, CT. Following seminary and a brief ministry stint in Jamaica, he returned to Connecticut where he has served the American Baptist Churches of Connecticut ever since.

An activist and trailblazer, Pastor Scott has held several leadership positions in community, including positions with the American Baptist Churches of Connecticut, and with the American Baptist Churches USA, on its General Board, Executive Committee, Committee on Christian Unity and Interfaith Relations, and as president of the Board of International Ministries. He has been involved in church, ecumenical, and city life in Connecticut, including Hartford and Bridgeport's Councils of Churches, the Bridgeport Clergy Association and as president of the Greater Bridgeport Interfaith Action.
